Rules

1. There is a one-time \$25 registration fee per horse & rider combination. The fee must be paid before the show will be used for award calculations – any show attended before the fee is paid will not be used in the award calculations. The last opportunity to register will be before the start of the June 15th show. TCHA membership is not required to compete in the Buckle Series.
2. Only the 4 rated events (Cloverleaf Barrels, Skill Barrels, Big T & Bi-Rangle) will be used for award calculations.
3. The combination must compete in all 4 rated events in a **minimum of 4 of the 6 series shows**.
4. Whatever division you are in at the start of the August 10th show (whether you ride or not) will be the division that you receive your award in.
5. Buckle Series High Point Champion Awards will be awarded to those competing in Divisions 1 through 7.
6. Daily high point awards will be given at each show. Buckle Series High Point Awards will be awarded at the end of the August 10th show by SPEED DIVISION.
7. All shows will run in accordance with CSHA rules.
8. Should a situation arise that is not covered in these rules, the 2019 Region 5 Gymkhana Rules and the CSHA State Rules will be consulted. The Gymkhana Committee will vote on the final outcome (and all Gymkhana Committee decisions are final)

Point Calculations for Buckle Series High Point Awards

1. At the end of the series, every registered combination's best 4 times for each of the rating events will be determined.
 - a. Times used will include any penalties assessed.
 - b. All non-registered and non-qualifying riders will be omitted before scores are tallied.
2. These times will then be placed against the top 4 times of all qualifying combinations in that speed division and points will be awarded and tallied. Each time for each combination will be placed 1st through 9th in that division and points will be awarded for those placings as follows:
1st=10, 2nd=8, 3rd=7, 4th=6, 5th=5, 6th=4, 7th=3, 8th=2, 9th=1
For example the fastest time from each combination per division will be placed against the fastest times of all the registered combinations in that division and points will be awarded. Then, the second fastest times will be compared and placed, on down to the 4th fastest times for each of the rated events.
