2019 Camping Schedule

Tri-Cities sponsor several **camping trips** every year. Following are the remaining camping trips for 2019. More info will be posted prior to each event.

9/27 - 29- Five Brooks Horse Camp, Pt. Reyes

Reservations are required and everyone that is attending is responsible for making your own reservations by calling Five Brooks Stables at 415-663-1570

The camping fee structure is as follows:

Per night: \$10 per site/trailer, \$10 per horse, \$10 per person
For example: 1 person with 1 horse in 1 trailer = \$30/night
2 people with 2 horses in 1 trailer = \$50/night

Note: Motor homes are counted as separate vehicles and charged an additional \$10/night as they take up room for an additional trailer.

When you call you will need a credit card to hold your reservation. If you use your credit card for payment there is an additional 7.5% charge. However you can pay with cash or check when you arrive. There is no additional charge if paying by cash or check.

If you need to cancel, you must call before 4:00 the day before or your credit card will be charged.

As in the past, sites are not assigned, just take the ones available.

No pens but highline poles are available in some sites, bring your own highline. You may bring your own portable pens.

Water for horses is available but bring your people water.

The restroom has showers.

Pets are not allowed, Natl Park policy.

No shavings allowed

Weed Free Feed is requested but not required due to lack of availability.

We will do a potluck Saturday night.

10/18 - 20 – Lake Oroville, Loafer Creek Horse Camp.

Campground includes, round pen, wash racks, flush restrooms and showers. Sites include 2 pens, table, fire ring and bbq. Everyone is responsible for making their own reservations. To make reservations go to www.reservecalifornia.com
