**5/17- 5/19 - Skyline Wilderness Park, Napa**

Shake out all the cobwebs and join us on the first camping trip of the season!

Learn how to camp with your horse in a location close to home.

Experienced campers will be there to help you and share tips and tricks. No pens but highline poles provided or you can bring your own pen.

**6/7 - 9 – Dru Barber Horse Camp, near Georgetown, riding Stanislaus Natl Forest.**

Limited pens available but you can bring your own or highline. Horse water is available; bring your drinking/cooking water. No Reservations, first come, first served. Camping fee is \$8.00/night.

**7/11 – 16 – Kennedy Meadows, Kennedy Meadows Resort**

6 Days/5 Nights of rustic camping at a location not normally open for public camping. Ride into the Emigrant Wilderness. No pens, bring high tie or high line or pens. Horse water and porta potties will be available, potluck dinners some nights. Primitive camping but there is a lodge with a restaurant, bar and showers. Mountain riding at it's best! Also meadow riding for the faint of heart ☺.
